During the meal, tour guides encourage families to participate in the Latin America National Geographic Trivia Game, by working with their Tour Guide Representative to select the correct answer before the other tables!

6:30 MISSION IMMERSION EXPERIENCES
(Location: Fellowship Hall + Sunday School Rooms + Outdoor Rec Area)

Adults interactively explore "familia" and global missions while youth engage in a hands-on "familia" experience of Latino culture and a missional understanding of God. Families engage in Latino culture and traditions and meet missionaries as they journey through four mission rotations: Art, Culture and Music, Food, and Soccer.
